REDS FROM THE VAULT

Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido (2013) £700
An iconic Super Tuscan wine from Bolgheri, Sassicaia is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The 2013 vintage is celebrated for its balance, elegance, and ageing potential. It offers a complex bouquet of blackcurrants, cedar, herbs, and hints of tobacco. On the palate, it delivers silky tannins and a harmonious blend of dark fruits, minerality, and spice.

Bonnes-Mares Grand Cru, Robert Groffier (2014) £1100
A prestigious red wine from Burgundy, known for its power and elegance. The Bonnes-Mares vineyard produces complex wines with notes of red and black fruits, earth, and spice. Ideal for pairing with rich dishes or aged cheeses.

Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Soldera (2004) £1800
From Tuscany, this Brunello is crafted with precision, offering earthy and floral aromas, complemented by cherry, leather, and spice on the palate.

Clos Vougeot Grand Cru, Mugneret-Gibourg (2010) £2200
A Burgundy classic from the historic Clos Vougeot vineyard. It offers aromas of ripe berries, violets, and subtle oak, with a structured and layered palate. Perfect for enhancing a cheese-focused menu.

Echézeaux Grand Cru, Mugneret-Gibourg (2017) £2700
A highly sought-after Pinot Noir balancing fruit and minerality. It delivers a vibrant bouquet of cherries, forest floor, and savoury herbs. Its silky texture makes it a luxurious choice for special occasions.

Château La Mission Haut-Brion, Pessac-Léognan (2010) £2800
A Bordeaux powerhouse, this blend from Pessac-Léognan combines Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc. Expect bold notes of blackcurrant, graphite, and tobacco, with a high-end offering.

Château Pétrus, Pomerol (2016) £7500
A legendary wine from Pomerol, known for its exclusivity and unmatched quality. Made predominantly from Merlot, it showcases opulent notes of plum, truffle, and cedar. A perfect centrepiece wine for a high-end offering.

WHITES FROM THE VAULT

Chablis 1er Cru Butteaux, Raveneau (2015) £900
A benchmark for Chablis, this wine combines minerality with delicate citrus and floral aromas. Crisp acidity and a touch of minerality on the finish make it ideal for enjoying with creamy or briny cheeses.

Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru, Lucien Le Moine (2016) £900
A grand cru Chardonnay from Burgundy, offering layers of richness and elegance. Notes of stone fruits, butter, and hazelnut define its luxurious character, perfect for complementing rich or creamy dishes.

WHITE WINES

Loire, France

Crisp green apples and white stone fruits give way to a subtle, nutty note. Crisp and fresh, with a creaminess from the time spent on its lees.

Pulenta Estate XIV Pinot Gris 2023 Bottle £40
Mendoza, Argentina

Fresh peaches, apricots and delicate white flowers on the nose. Delicate & fruity with a fresh, balancing acidity and a long, elegant finish.

Spring Fever Chardonnay, Langneil 2022 Bottle £43

With a fresh and fruity palate full of stone fruit and citrus notes with hints of tropical fruit, citrus zest, cream and a touch of minerality on the finish.

Resplendent with flavours of peaches, apricots and apples against delicate hints of wild flowers. The palate is rich and textured, with a fresh underlying acidity and a supple, saline note as a counterpoint to the ripe fruit.

Albariño
From the coolest part of Rias Baixas, this wine bursts with juicy Albariño character; pear, citrus fruit, musky perfume and hints of mineral and spice. Clean, intense and very long on the palate.

Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough (Organic) 2023 Bottle £49
South Island, New Zealand

Classic citrus and crisp apple aromas, with some gentle tropical undertones on the nose. The palate combines fresh citrus and lemon peel, with a saline acidity and a subtle smokiness on the finish.

Riesling Calcaires Jaunes, Muré (Organic) 2023 £53

A fresh nose with aromas of fruit, particularly citrus. Rich and elegant on the palate, with a streak of lime freshness. Exotic fruit and minerality finish.

Sauvignon Blanc
A lively, intense nose of green fruit, then focused minerally notes on the palate backed up by zippy citrus and some spice and mint flavours.

Conde Valdemar Rioja Blanco Finca Alto Cantabria 2021 £58

Viura
A successful blend of modern fruit and traditional oak ageing; lemony, smoke- and vanilla-scented, with subtle aromas of peaches and apricot, and beautifully balanced.

Gavi di Gavi Bruno Broglio 2020 £60
Piedmont, Italy
Cortese
This top selection shows great refinement and minerality on the nose, with a nutty savouriness on the palate. Taut, concentrated and structured, it sets the benchmark for great Gavi.

Friuli Venezia Giulia, Italy
Pinot Grigio
This Pinot Grigio has an intense straw-yellow colour; its aroma is intense, full and fruity, with excellent persistence

Mandolés Dry Furmint, Oremus 2021 £63
Tokaj, Hungary
Furmint
This combines Furmint's bold acidity with flavours of juicy dessert apples and white flowers. The texture is almost waxy, with a pleasing saline note on the lengthy finish.

Sancerre La Croix du Roy, Crochet 2022 £65
Loire, France
Sauvignon Blanc
Notes of citrus fruits, blossom, peach and pear on the nose. Nice pure entry, juicy and crisp on the palate. Good original classic mineral flavours.

WHITE WINES

Domaine de la Solitude Blanc, Pessac-Léognan 2017 £70
Bordeaux, France

Domaine de la Solitude Blanc offers explosive floral and fruity aromas of acacia, peach, citrus and exotic fruits. The palate is rich and fresh with a typical mineral accent and the finish is long and exquisite.

Roseneck Chardonnay, Drouhin Oregon 2022 £71

Chardonnay
The aromatics range from classic white flowers to tart lemon meringue. There is texture and energy, with bright acidity and well-integrated oak.

Chablis 1er Cru Montmains Organic, Brocard 2022 £72
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
Spicy notes with flint and citrus fruit aromas on the nose, followed by a subtle palate showing beautiful minerality and notes of lemon.

Granito Cru Dão Branco, Luis Seabra 2022 £80
Dão, Portugal
White Blend
This wine presents a citrusy profile, vibrant freshness, and a creamy texture. The finish lingers, marked by delightful hints of salinity.

Condrieu Les Mandoules, Ferraton 2022 £85
Rhône, France
Viognier
Unmistakably Condrieu, with flavours of ripe peach, apricot and honeysuckle. Well balanced with a silkiness so typical of the appellation.

Ridge Grenache Blanc 2023 £87
California, USA
Grenache Blanc
Aromas of white flowers, peach, ripe melon, pineapple and wet stone. A bright and clean entry with medium body. Complex mouthfeel with minerality and fresh natural acidity lead to a mouthwatering finish.

Pouilly-Fuissé 1er Cru Sur La Roche, Rijckaert 2022 £90
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
Exhilarating freshness, a spicy honeysuckle and acacia rich nose, showing ripe and abundant fruits on the palate with a creamy soft mouthfeel, sharpened by a taut mineral profile and saline zesty finish.

Châteauneuf blanc Boisenard, Beurenard (Organic) 2021 £110
Rhône, France

The domaine's top wine is also their most textural; from ancient, low-yielding vines, it offers great depth, alongside aromas of honeysuckle, pears and spice.

Meursault Les Petits Charbons, Bernard Millot 2021 £130

Chardonnay
The dress is yellow gold, a woody nose, the soil is quite marked. The mouth is straight, fleshy, harmonious with aromas of butter, and a touch of citrus.

Ermitage blanc Le Reverdy, Ferraton (Organic) 2020 £145
Rhône, France
White Blend
Full bodied and intense with flavours of baked fruit, citrus, ginger, honeysuckle, brioche and toasted nuts. The ripeness is perfectly offset by the acidity which creates the complex and concentrated core through to an elegant finish.

Chassagne-Montrachet, Xavier Monnot 2022 £160
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
The wine boasts a brilliant golden colour and offers an elegant bouquet of citrus, floral and mineral notes, with a hint of toasted almonds.

Puligny-Montrachet, François Carillon 2020 £190
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
An elegant nose of peaches, citrus and acacia flowers is followed by a palate with a real concentration of both fruit and savoury, mineral flavours.

Chassagne 1er Cru Morgot, Lucien Le Moine 2021 £250
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
This Chassagne Montrachet exudes a golden hue, hinting at its maturity and depth. Captivating aromas with delicate notes of ripe pear, white peach, and lemon zest with hints of toasted oak and a subtle floral undertone.

Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru, Xavier Monnot 2020 £325
Burgundy, France
Chardonnay
Aromas of apricots, citrus and toasted hazelnut are echoed on the rich, opulent palate. Well-structured, with a perfect balance between ripe fruit and savoury, mineral complexity; the finish is lengthy and harmonious.

RED WINES

Côtes-du-Rhône Samoréens rouge, Ferraton 2023 Bottle £38
Rhône, France
Grenache

Medium to full-bodied, the bright, fresh cherry and berry fruit is followed by a savoury earthy note and lifted by floral, peppery aromas. The tannins are silky and well rounded and the finish is fresh.

Conde Valdemar Rioja Crianza (Cork Closure) 2019 Bottle £40
Rioja, Spain

Complex aromas of ripe black berries balanced with warm vanilla notes and a touch of black spice. Excellent, rounded structure on the palate with a lasting aromatic complexity.

Montepulciano
Flavours of ripe plums and red cherries give way to balsamic and savoury notes. The palate is full-bodied, with plush, velvety tannins and the finish is long and intense, with subtle notes of liquorice and spice.

Hussonet Gran Reserve Cab Sauv, Haras (Organic) 2019 Bottle £45
Rhône Central, Chile

Intense, elegant nose with notes of mint, spices and liquorice, leading into ripe flavours of blackberry, plum and cassia. Generously structured on the palate with a seam of earthy minerality.

Brouilly, Domaine de la Martingale 2021 £48

Gamay
Deep ruby colour, with intense aromas of red and black fruits. Well balanced and full bodied, with fine and elegant tannins.

Altura Cabernet Franc, Norton 2021 £49
Mendoza, Argentina
Cabernet Franc
A bright, intense Cabernet Franc, marrying ripe yet fresh berry flavours with herbaceous and winny notes. A fresh acidity lifts the palate and notes of spice and smoke add complexity to the finish.

Pulenta Estate I Malbec 2021 Bottle £52

The nose combines red and black fruits with appealing floral notes, followed by a lush, well-rounded palate with a fruit profile that blends freshness and intensity. The oak ageing has lent a spicy character with a complex mineral streak.

Bold aromas of ripe red fruits are followed by spicy notes of cinnamon and clove. The palate shows flavours of raspberry and black cherry with hints of mecha & cardamom which last through to the bright, fresh finish.

Bordeaux Blend
Up front there are bold raspberry and blackcurrant flavours that give way to leathery, spicy notes. There is a touch of vanilla from the oak and the rich, mellow tannins are complemented by refreshing acidity on the finish.

Tempranillo
A powerful expression of black fruit, white chocolate, plums & spices. These aromas are perfectly combined with the smokiness provided by French oak barrels. Round and full-bodied, elegant and ripe.

RED WINES

Château Peynouton, Saint-Emission Grand Cru 2018 £64
Bordeaux, France
Merlot
Dark fruit with aromas of rich ripe cassis and earthy nuances. On the palate blackberry & bramble with a hint of tobacco and cedar open up to gentle tannins.

Il Bruciato, Tenuta Guado al Tasso, Antinori 2021 £67
Tuscany, Italy
Bordeaux Blend
Fragrant fruity aromas, particularly plum, followed by delicate mint and green tea notes. On the palate it is full-bodied and smooth with a long finish.

Lethbridge Shiraz 2021 £70
Victoria, Australia
Shiraz
Aromatic and finely etched, this Shiraz combines vivid scents of blackberry, pepper, elderberry and violets with a firm, muscular structure. An exuberant dryness offsets the rich ripe fruit. Thrilling, dynamic Victoria Shiraz.

Rully Rouge Chaponnières, Jacqueson 2022 £72
Burgundy, France
Pinot Noir
The nose is marked by the aromas of red fruits, with wonderful ripeness and depth. The palate is generous, framed by a touch of wood, with good intensity but mouthwatering freshness.

Crozes-Ermitage Le Grand Courtil, Ferraton 2021 £75
Syrah
An expressive and perfumed Syrah, with notes of succulent black cherry, toast and subtle violets. The tannins are silky and in perfect balance with the fresh acidity.

Pulenta Estate X Gran Malbec 2020 £77
Mendoza, Argentina
Malbec
Combining both intensity and freshness with aplomb, the Gran Malbec is redolent with bright cherry fruit and floral complexity on the nose, followed by ripe plums, vanilla and toasty oak on the palate.

Meerlust Rubicon 2018 £80
Coastal Region, South Africa
Bordeaux Blend
Very deep, youthful colour, and intense almost purple hue. Quintessential Rubicon nose with violets, ripe plum, cedar wood, fennel, and intense spiciness.

Fragrant notes of ripe fruits, violets and cedar with beautiful lengthy and delicate tannins. Great structure, balance and a long finish.

A complex nose of bright red fruit, pepper and toasty oak is followed by a full-bodied palate and a complex finish of liquorice and plum fruit with bold but well integrated tannins.

Badia a Passignano Chianti Classico Gran Selezione 2020 £100
Tuscany, Italy
Sangiovese
The nose offers a wide range of fruity aromas as well as hints of liquorice and ripe blackberries. The complex, elegant palate shows plenty of fruit alongside savoury flavours, finishing long and vibrant.

RED WINES

Riserva Costasera Amarone Classico, Masi 2018 £115
Veneto, Italy
Red Blend
Plums and baked cherries on the nose with hints of bay leaf. Magnificently rich and soft on the palate with rich cherry and blueberry flavours and some sweet spice. Long, dry finish with a touch of fresh blueberries.

Châteauneuf Boisenard, Dom de Beurenard (Org) 2020 £120
Rhône, France
Red Blend
From the oldest vines on the estate comes this dense, inky, hugely concentrated mouthful of blackberry fruit. Fresher than so many juicy cins, this is benchmark stuff, with notes of blueberries and oriental spices adding complexity.

Pintia, Tempos Vega Sicilia 2018 £125
Castilla y León, Spain
Tempranillo
The wine is deep with great intensity of fruit and offers a good tannic structure and a very friendly, fresh and persistent palate.

Château Kirwan, Margaux 2017 £130
Bordeaux, France
Bordeaux Blend
Fresh and pure red berry fruit aromas with notes of tobacco and violets. The palate is complex and delicate with a good balance and great length. A classic Margaux.

Château Bataille, Paillet 2017 £150
Bordeaux, France
Nebbiolo
A classic Paillet, with intense flavour, great structure and ripe tannins. Fresh and earthy, with forest fruits, tobacco, cassis and chocolate notes.

Alfon, Tempos Vega Sicilia 2020 £165
Castilla y León, Spain
Tempranillo
Prominent black and red fruit flavours give way to a savoury, earthy note with just a hint of toasty oak. The tannins are youthful but still juicy and well-rounded and the fine acidity brings the freshness and elegance we expect from this estate.

Gevrey-Chambertin Vieilles Vignes, J-M Guillon 2021 £175
Burgundy, France
A magnificently dark, powerful Gevrey-Chambertin that showcases the power of old-vine fruit. With plums, raspberry and fresh fig fruit, a densely packed but still finely detailed palate, and plenty of freshness on the long finish.

Ermitage Le Méal, Ferraton (Organic) 2019 £185
Rhône, France
Syrah
This beautiful wine is full, lush, and rich in every respect. Plum, cassis and fig mingle with accents of liquorice, savoury herbs and graphite in layers upon layers of flavour.

Vignaferravia Brunello Riserva, Pian delle Vigne 2018 £195
Tuscany, Italy
Sangiovese
A firm full bodied wine with high perfumed aromas and ripe dark chocolatey fruit flavours in the mouth. Exceptional concentration.

Barolo Mosconi, Prunotto 2019 £205
Piedmont, Italy
Nebbiolo
The nose expresses hints of sage, rosemary and undergrowth, combined with sensations of flowers and spicy notes. On the palate it is broad, elegant and characterized by an important tannic structure. The finish is long and persistent.

RED WINES

Alter Ego de Palmer, Margaux 2017 £215

Dense and powerful, with ripe, juicy plum and cherry fruit, aromatic blueberries, and brighter, crunchily black berry fruit. Spicy cedar, liquorice and mint

Tignanello, Antinori 2020 £225

Sangiovese
Exceptional aromatic complexity: notes of ripe red fruit especially cherries, strawberries and blackberries are accompanied by delicate floral hints of violets, mallow blossoms and roses. Its bouquet is completed by notes of roasted coffee and cocoa powder.

Château Rauzan-Ségla, Margaux 2014 £235
Bordeaux, France
Bordeaux Blend
Showing great elegance, this enticing wine has a lovely aromatic freshness. The nose mingles scents of ripe black fruit with subtle notes of precious wood and rose petals.

Chambolle 1er Cru Les Hauts Doix, Lucien Le Moine 2018 £270
Burgundy, France
Pinot Noir
A dark, open-knit style, this red displays lush black cherry, blackberry and black currant flavours, with generous smoky oak and sweet spice accents. Reveals a vein of vibrant acidity that keeps this delineated, with a lingering finish marked by graphite.

Barbaresco, Gaja 2016 £375
Piedmont, Italy
Nebbiolo
Notes of rose petal, mint, red berry fruits and impressive structure. This is truly a masterpiece of wine.

Vosne-Romanée 1er Cru Les Chaumes 2021 £415
Lucien Le Moine
"Les Chaumes" is characterised by its finesse and elegance. This elegant and ample wine is supported by velvet tannins. Young, it is fleshy and very aromatic.

Vega Sicilia Unico 2013 £525
Castilla y León, Spain
Tempranillo
An absolutely wonderful nose and palate, with fine red and blackberry fruit, lifted cedar spice, and endless length.

Château Léoville-Las Cases, Saint-Julien 1996 £550
Bordeaux, France
Bordeaux Blend
Beautifully defined with intense black cherries, cedar, mint and a touch of oyster shell that seems to gain intensity in the glass. The palate is seamless from start to finish, extraordinarily pure, the 70% new oak totally assimilated of course, impressive weight and power allied with genuine finesse and tension towards the silky smooth finish.

A real beauty that has everything you could want from a wine. With notes of cassis, Asian spices, dried flowers, and incense all soar from the glass, and on the palate, it's medium to full-bodied and pure, with ripe tannins and a great finish.

Great depth and richness and complexity – and yet this manages to be racy and delicate too. Real lift and freshness. The hedonistic fruit cunningly disguises what is still a heavy charge of tannin.

ROSE WINES

Fresh and pink in colour, this wine shows intense yet delicate fragrances of pink grapefruit, peaches and violets. Fresh and balanced with savoury notes and excellent aromatic.

An aromatic nose, combining watermelon, citrus and rose floral characters with a hint of lime. The palate brings forward more melon and strawberry flavours with grapefruit on the finish.

A vibrant and delicate rosé, with fresh summer berries and melon apparent on the nose. Nextarine and citrus lead the palate with a nice textural richness.

Château Sainte Marguerite Fantastique (Organic) 2023 £80

An elegant bouquet, brimming with ripe, vibrant peaches, raspberries and plums. The palate follows on with nuances of exotic guava and papaya, with a delicate floral note.

SPARKLING WINES

Casa Canvel Prosecco Extra Dry Bottle £39

Superbly drinkable Prosecco: soft, aromatic and fresh with the perfect balance between crisp apple and floral blossom notes, carried by the gentle, seductive mousse.

Pale gold, with subtle pink and silver glints. The notes of citrus fruits and ripe apples and pears on the mid-palate give way to a crisp finish.

An enticing blend of fruit and oral scents, whilst the flavours bring more exactly cranberry notes alongside ripe pears and rosewater.

Refined, creamy sparkling wine that offers a brilliant balance between chalky, fruity/floral and yeasty, breadly notes. The mousse is extremely fine and the palate dry without being austere. With impressive richness on the finish, this is one of England's 75

Pinot Noir
A luxurious and rich rosé with beautiful ripe forest fruits, raspberries and hibiscus aromas.

Franciacorta Cuvée Prestige Ed. 46, Ca' del Bosco 2021 £75
Lombardy, Italy
White Blend
A classy example of Franciacorta, combining rich flavours of toasted brioche, buttery crumb, baked apricots and almonds with a subtle hint of liquorice.

Pol Roger Brut Reserve £95
Champagne, France
This Champagne is dominated by green apple and brioche. On the palate there is a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity.

Veuve Clicquot Rosé £110
Champagne, France
The nose is elegant and generous, with initial aromas of fresh red fruit (raspberry, wild strawberry, cherry and blackberry) leading to dried fruits and viscous notes (almonds, apricots and brioche).

Laurent-Perrier Rosé £130
Champagne, France
A precise nose of extraordinary freshness and a wide range of red fruits: raspberry, redcurrant, strawberry and black cherry.

Champagne Drappier Quatuor (Organic) £160
Champagne, France
This unique blend of four white grape varieties is as complex and distinctive as you would expect: aromas of fresh grapes, dry, red apple and fig are followed by a powerful, dry, multi-layered palate.

Bollinger Grande Année 2015 £250
Champagne, France
With notes of pear, orange oil and white flowers mingled with notions of mocha, toasted hazelnuts and fine sherry, it's medium to full-bodied, layered and textural, with a dense core of fruit framed by chalky structuring extract, concluding with a long, rapid finish.

Louis Roederer Cristal 2012 £400
Champagne, France
Rich and complex aromas with notes of zesty and candied fruit (lemon) mingled with pollen (white flowers), roasted hazelnut and Madagascar vanilla.

Dom Pérignon Rosé 2009 £550
Champagne, France
Dom Pérignon Rosé 2009 is radiant, its fruit appears with all its majesty, round, rich and generous. The wine displays all the aromatic nuances of Pinot Noir – raspberry, fig, strawberry and cherry – exacerbated by the delicacy, mineral elegance and light notes of chardonnay.

Krug Vintage 2011 £565
Champagne, France
This unique blend of four white grape varieties is as complex and distinctive as you would expect: aromas of fresh grapes, dry, red apple and fig are followed by a powerful, dry, multi-layered palate.
